He coordinates with other departments to ensure the underground mine has what it needs to operate. Maintaining good relationships with the maintenance, technical, processing, logistics, and other teams across the business is vital to the success of the underground mine.

Regular duties include involvement in planning processes and meetings, hiring new workers, review and approval of mine plans, and time in the field. He regularly goes underground to inspect mining areas and discuss safety and operational requirements with operators.
