As an investigator at the Ekati mine, Winnie is responsible for tracking down important details that affect the overall safety of the mine. She works a two week on, two week off rotation, and her two weeks at work are always busy. Some of her regular duties include conducting background investigations; carrying out compliancy audits and surveillance; and responding to incident investigations.

Working in the security department requires the ability to build and maintain rapport with stakeholders; knowledge of the criminal code, human resources policies and privacy legislation; as well as familiarity with several security systems.

When asked if she had any advice for a young person thinking of working in the mining industry, Winnie said, "Seriously consider it, there are endless opportunities and support for you. Stay positive, keep your sense of humor and be clear on your goals."
